


Stampede Breakfast and Service, July 9. The Stampede Fiddlers


### From the Rector

# Stewardship

**Budget Challenge** – Offerings were below forecast in May so we are left with a major challenge in June to avoid a deficit for the year. We were in a similar situation in June last year, and thanks to your generous response we were able to end the year with a small surplus. If you have not completed your pledge for this year we would ask that you do so by June 30<sup>th</sup>. All gifts received on or before June 30<sup>th</sup> will be counted for this fiscal year.

Pledge Goal – We are extremely grateful for the strong and steady response to our annual pledge appeal. We have received 107 pledges to date totaling over \$385,000. That represents 63% of our pledge goal for the 2017-8 fiscal year which is \$609,000. Watch our "pledge thermometer" rise each week in the bulletin. Thermometers can also be found in the Loggia and Crump Room and on our event calendar video screen. Two-thirds of those who pledged to date included an increase to help us reach our goal of restoring the Associate Priest position this fall.



13<sup>th</sup> Month – To assist us in reducing our deficit this year we are asking parishioners to consider making a "13th month" offering. For example, if you currently give \$100 per month, we are asking you for an additional special offering gift of \$100 over and above your normal giving. This initiative comes as we seek to end 2016-7 in a financially strong position and to provide the necessary resources to restore our Associate Priest position. I hope many will join with me and many others in making a 13th month gift!
