Message from the Treasurer

At the last AGM we shared the ongoing financial challenges that Christ Church has experienced. Such challenges have existed for the last couple of years. Past deficits have been successfully addressed through various funding campaigns, gifts and grants. We have decided there is a need for more sustainable revenue strategies. To this end we have reestablished a stewardship committee that will focus on enhanced financial communications

and contribution strategies. This is the first in a series of regular financial reports to our parishioners. Year to Date Offerings vs Expenses **Key Points:** Actual expenses are slightly below budget. This year's budget has \$265,658 already been significantly reduced from last year. Poinsettias


