
Have you thought about baptism? Speak to Adam about having you or your infants baptized on November 24 at our 10:30 am service.


Blessing of the Animals | September 29, 2 pm

This construction update reflects the new dates for signals work at Elbow Drive at 4 Street SW to 5 Street SW. Site conditions did not allow the work to be completed on September 15 and the work is now planned for the end of September.

Beginning at 7 p.m. on Thursday, September 26 until 7 p.m. on Wednesday, October 2, Elbow Drive at 4 Street SW to 5

Street SW will be closed to allow for signals work.

Pedestrians and wheelers can still access the bridge during this closure by using the west-sidewalk.

For those travelling through the area by vehicle, signs and detours will be posted to help you navigate the area. East and westbound vehicles will be detoured on 25 Avenue

SW.



Prayer Shawls - "Tangible Evidence of Prayer" (ref: "The Prayer


